ABOUT HILLHEAD HOUSING ASSOCIATION 2000

Hillhead Housing Association 2000 is a charitable housing association. It was established in December 1998 by representatives of Hillhead Initiative for Tenants and East Dunbartonshire Council for the purpose of taking ownership of the Council's houses in Hillhead. The Association took ownership of EDC houses in Hillhead in early 2004 and own and manage around 820 properties.

We are run by volunteers, many of them local residents, who have a clear idea of what is needed to make Hillhead a better place to live. We don't just try to deal with housing problems but want to tackle all the problems in the area.

The main principle is that volunteers have the good of the community at heart and wish to help make Hillhead a better place to stay.

We do not trade for profit. Any surplus income is invested in order to pay for future repairs to the properties.

A Management Committee which is elected from its membership, runs the Association. The Management Committee makes all the important decisions about what the Association should be doing and how this should be done. Staff are employed by the Management Committee to act on these decisions and to carry out the day to day work of the Association.
