

APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO KEEP A PET

The Association welcomes <u>responsible</u> pet ownership but in order to ensure that other residents do not have the enjoyment of their homes and surroundings spoiled, we have certain rules regarding the keeping of pets. These rules are summarised below and in the Declaration overleaf:

You should note that you <u>do not</u> require permission for animals kept permanently in cages or tanks providing they are kept securely and do not cause a nuisance or health hazard to others in the vicinity.

You <u>do</u> require permission to keep one domestic pet which is <u>not</u> caged or in a tank eg. dog, cat etc. This permission will automatically be granted (subject to the conditions noted in the Declaration overleaf) if you live in a property with its own private garden and secure boundaries such as a terraced or semidetached house. Permission to keep more than one pet will be at the discretion of the Association which will consider the size of the property and the suitability of arrangements for keeping and controlling the animals.

Permission to keep a dangerous dog, as defined by the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991 and the Dangerous Dogs (Amendment) Act 1997, will only be granted where you can provide proof of Police Registration and a certificate confirming the dog has been neutered. Permission will not be granted for animals which would be subject to the Dangerous Wild Animals Act 1976.

If you live in a flat (tenement or four-in-a-block), permission to keep <u>one</u> dog <u>or</u> <u>one</u> cat will be at the discretion of the Association which will assess how many other animals are kept in the property and whether the addition of a further animal to the property would be likely to adversely impact on other residents.

<u>The Association keeps a supply of "Poop Scoop" Bags for use</u> when walking a dog. If you require these, please call into the office.
